#### **Attendance**




#### **Christmas Shoeboxes**

## Remembrance Service

#### Reminders

#### **Drop Off**

You can drop off your child from 8.30 am in the school carpark. Adults will be there to supervise this from 8.30 am, please do not drop your child off before this as no adults will there. Buddies are still meeting their friends from Lake class.

Please can you ensure that your child is in school by 8.40am so that they can begin their learning and enjoy the start of their day. If your child is ill, please can you ring the office or email us before 9am on the day so we can record their absence.

#### Collection at the end of the day

The children will be brought up to the field for you to collect them at the end of the day. Key Stage 1 collection is at 3pm and Key Stage 2 is at 3.10pm.

Lake Class, Wilsford and Durnford leave from the first gate, Lower Woodford, Netton, Upper Woodford and Salterton from the middle gate.

#### PE Kits

Children need to bring in their PE kits and can leave them in school, please can you make sure that it is labelled as it can wander off on its own! It is a good idea to check the children have long sleeved tops and tracksuit bottoms this time of year as we still go outside as much as possible.

#### Uniform

Uniform is an important part of our school identity, and we ask that all children wear the appropriate school uniform each day. This helps to create a sense of community and pride among students. Please ensure that each item of clothing is clearly labelled with your child's name to prevent any mix-ups.

Please can we also ask you not to send pupils in wearing jewellery, only watches (not Smart watches) or simple studs or sleepers in ears that are pierced. Long hair should be tied back and no nail varnish or false nails to be worn in school.

#### Lunch and Snacks

We encourage healthy eating habits, so please provide your child with a nutritious lunch and fruit or vegetable snacks. Remember, we are a nut-free school due to allergies, so avoid including any nuts or nut products in your child's lunchbox. If your child has any special dietary requirements, please inform the school office so we can accommodate their needs.

#### Parent-Teacher Communication

We believe in maintaining open lines of communication between parents and teachers. Regular updates will be provided through newsletters and the Parent Pay app. If you have any concerns or questions, please feel free to contact your child's teacher in the first instance through the school office, where an appointment will be made for you.
